Camp Fact Sheet

July 14-16 (completed K-3) and July 21-23 (completed grades 4-6)

Dear parents and campers,

It's almost time for Superkids 2011! This fact sheet includes important information to help you get ready for camp. If you have questions, visit our website at www.superkidsonline.org or call toll 1-87-SUPERKID.

What time does camp start?

Camp starts on Thursday evenings with check-in from 6:00 to 7:00 PM. Please do not arrive at camp before 5:30 PM. **All baggage will be inspected prior to entering the building.** Be sure to read the *FAST PASS* information for speedy check-in.

Stuff not to bring to camp...

Please do not bring radios, CD players iPods, MP3 players, weapons, cell phone or hand held games.

Saturday Night at Superkids

Parents, grandparents, friends and your neighbors are invited to the closing celebration on Saturday at 5:00 PM.

After the service, all campers will return to their sleeping rooms for pick-up. Parents will be issued a pick-up card at check-in. Please bring the pick-up card with you so the card and camper number can be matched. Please understand that parents will not be permitted to enter the sleeping areas until *after* the closing service.

Check-in line procedure for 2011

Guests will enter one of two lines for check-in, standard or *FAST PASS*. All check-in stations will be equipped to serve all children. Guests will be served at the next available check-in location.

What do you do after check-in?

After checking in for camp, staff will be available to help you carry your things to your sleeping room.

Will you be taking medicine at camp?

If taking medicine, it must be checked in with the nurse. The nurse administers all medicine. Prescription medicine must be in the original bottle.

Health and Release Form

A health and release form must be completed for each child attending camp. If you have not already completed a health form, one is included with this fact sheet. Health forms are also available online at our website.

Where is Fairfield Christian Church?

The church is located at 1965 N. Columbus Street in Lancaster. Take Whittier Drive (across from the main entrance to River Valley Mall) across Memorial Drive (Rt. 33) and the church will be on the left. Please enter at door B.

What do you need to bring to camp?

- sleeping bag and pillow
- modest casual clothes and underclothes
- towels and washcloths
- personal stuff (toothbrush, toothpaste...)
- bathing suit (to wear in the shower)
- stuffed animal (optional)

What if you forget to bring something?

Superkids will have extra supplies available including toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, soap and towels. If you need something, just ask.

FAST PASS is the speedy way for your child to be checked in at camp!

Here's how it works...

1. Complete the health form and return to Superkids at Box 549, Pickerington, Ohio 43147 by Tuesday, July 12.
2. Your child must require no medicine to be given to the camp nurse.
3. Your child cannot request any group changes.

At check-in, enter the *FAST PASS* line, give your child's name, get a wrist band and pick-up card and your child is ready for camp! It's that simple!

A few notes...

1. The nurse station is stocked with non-prescription medicine including Tylenol and Pepto Bismol. You will not need to send these type items.
2. **Please attach the enclosed tags to your baggage and sleeping bag for easy identification.**
3. Please remember to tell your friends that pre-registration is required for camp. Walk-ons will only be permitted to stay if there is space available after check-in closes at 7:00 PM.
